## **Security in Emerging Networking Technologies (SENT)**

### **Aims and Scope**

The recent rise of emerging networking technologies such as social networks, content centric networks, IoT networks, etc. have attracted lots of attention from academia as well as industry. The purpose of this special session is to disseminate cutting-edge research results, highlight research challenges and open issues, and promotes further research interest and activities in security and privacy in emerging networking technologies.

The topics of **SENT** includes, but is not limited to the following topics:

- Security of content centric networks
- e-gov /m-gov/ security of information
- Social intelligence/ Artificial Intelligence
- Trust models in emerging social networks
- Privacy models for emerging social networks
- VANET/MANET security

## Submission procedure

We invite researchers to submit scientific papers which should not exceed 10 pages using the **Springer** templates (<u>Latex template</u>, <u>Word template</u>) without page numbers. Please select the acronym of the special session when submitting your paper on the Easychair system. Submitted papers are selected based on their originality, relevance to the Special session topics and technical soundness, following a double blind peer-revewing process. Authors names and affiliations should

be deleted from the submitted version. Self-references should be in the third person. One of the authors of an accepted submission should attend the conference to present the work. Papers should be submitted in PDF format through the Easychair system. Please note that English is the only accepted language for writing and presenting papers. Registered and presented papers will be submitted for inclusion in **Springer Library**.
